

MMB MUSIC'S
"BACK TO SCHOOL LESSON"
CONTEST OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CONTEST. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** This Contest is open only to legal residents of the contiguous United States and the District of Columbia, who are Music Educators, and who are 18 years of age or older at the time of entry. A "Music Educator" is defined as a person who is certified by a state or national organization to teach music, including retired persons who were certified but are no longer certified due to their retirement; and pre-service students who are enrolled in a school-sponsored program designed to prepare students for certification. You need not be present to win. Employees (and their immediate families or those living in the same household) of MMB Music ("Sponsor") and its respective affiliates, subsidiaries, divisions, parent and related companies, suppliers, printers and advertising, promotional and judging agencies are not eligible to enter or win.
2. **HOW TO ENTER:** Contest begins at 12:01 a.m. EDT on July 12, 2017 and ends at 12:59 p.m. EDT on August 9, 2017 ("Contest Period"). You will be required to submit a lesson that includes objectives, connections to National Standards and a step-by-step description of the lesson and process for teaching. The lessons will be reviewed by a selection committee consisting of three (3) individuals chosen by Sponsor. The selection committee will choose one (1) **lesson that best represents** student-centered, Orff-inspired teaching. **This lesson** will be declared the winner. The selection committee has sole and absolute discretion to select the winning entries, and all decisions by the selection committee are final. **You may enter only once.** All entries must be received by 12:59 p.m. EDT of the last date of the Contest, i.e. August 9, 2017. All entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be returned.
3. **PRIZES AND APPROXIMATE RETAIL VALUE:** The Prize consists solely of a Studio 49 KBN Resontaur Bell Set 1c and Case. The approximate total retail value of the Prize is \$708.75. All federal, state, and local tax liabilities are the sole responsibility of the Winner.
